- BACKGROUND** The Biofeedback Foundation of Europe (BFE) is a non-profit foundation “Stichting” located in the Netherlands. The Foundation is sponsored by corporations, non-profit organizations, an annual conference and the "Learn from the Best" program.
- JOIN A TEAM:** Each BFE International Research & Education Project (IREP) team has 18 people working together in 3 groups; research, education & training. Professionals choose a team and are then trained to work in real time over the internet in the group of their choice.

- 1. Education: Promote events, seminars & workshops**
 - 2. Research: Publish software, methodologies & reports**
 - 3. Training: Create continuing education courses**

**TEAM ROLES /
POSITIONS**

- 1. Sponsor** Sponsors, corporate and non-profit, support IREP teams with in-kind contributions, services & cash donations.
- 2. Opinion Leader** Opinion Leaders (clients-patients-subjects) provide data and testimonials to IREP team(s).
- 3. Clinical Leader** Clinical Leaders provide clinical expertise to the IREP team and represent the team at conferences & workshops.
- 4. Team Leader** Team Leaders facilitate communications between the IREP team & represent the team at professional & public events.
- 5. Research Leader** Research Leaders supervise funded students doing masters or doctoral level pilot and formal research studies.
- 6. Co-Instructor** Co-Instructors train team members to use software for one or more types of biofeedback.
- 7. Course Instructor** Course Instructors teach courses on specific biofeedback or neurofeedback methods within their area of competence.
- 8. Course Assistant** Course Assistants help course instructors online or live to overcome any technical and/or technological difficulties.
- 9. Biomedical Engineer** Biomedical Engineers write requirements based on IREP Team needs for future generations of hardware & software.
- 10. Software Developer** Software Developers build software to record, review and report on data for evidence-based research.
- 11. Clinician** Clinicians participate in online courses and workshops to learn how to use biofeedback in their practice.
- 12. Education Leader** Education Leaders review learning materials for interactive online courseware within their area of competence.
- 13. Physician** Physicians participate in online courses and workshops to keep abreast of research and practice to help their patients.
- 14. Education Assistant** Education Assistants go into each team account and reply to and file the correspondence.
- 15. Research Assistant** Research Assistants create software and documents for their team and for the team sponsors.
- 16. Education Assistant** Education Assistant create documents for the Learn From the Best program for the team .
- 17. Technician** Technicians make sure that the hardware and software needed for the team works properly.
- 18. Professional** Professionals participate in online courses and workshops to learn how to use biofeedback in their profession.
